Very good photo. Subject has several areas that are not as sharp as they should be. Crop out fuzzy flowers.

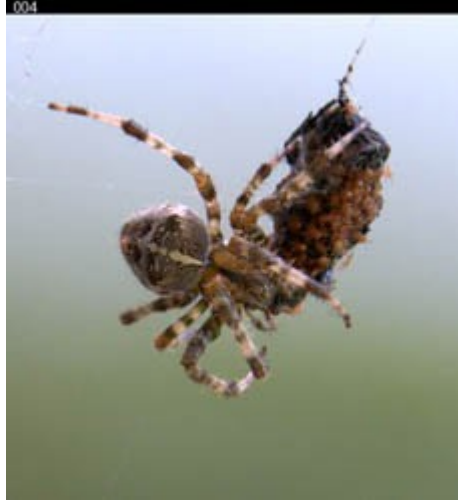

Difficult exposure extremely well handled

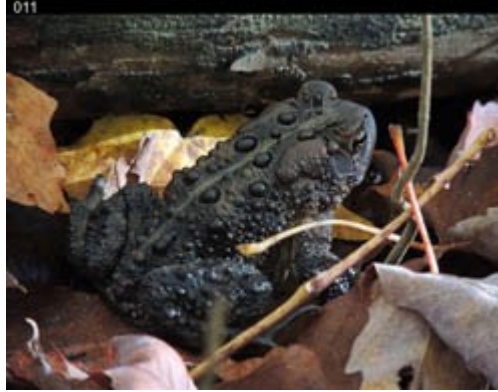

Our eyes read left to right. Large dark tree on left hinders that. Nice scene with no centre of interest.

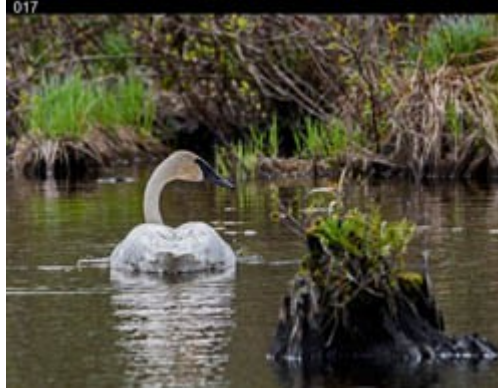

Good photo. Space should be in front of deer. Not behind. Give him somewhere to go.

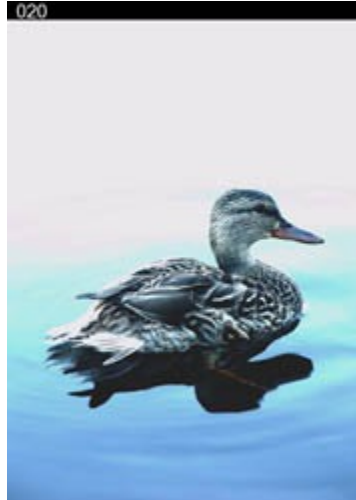

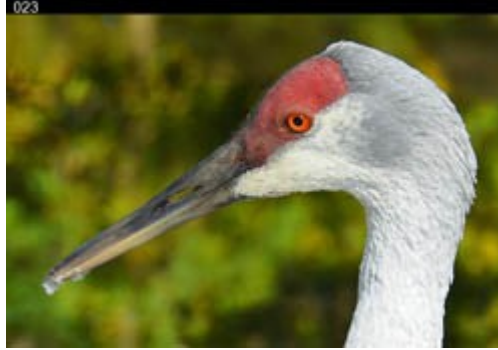
