- I have started shooting film

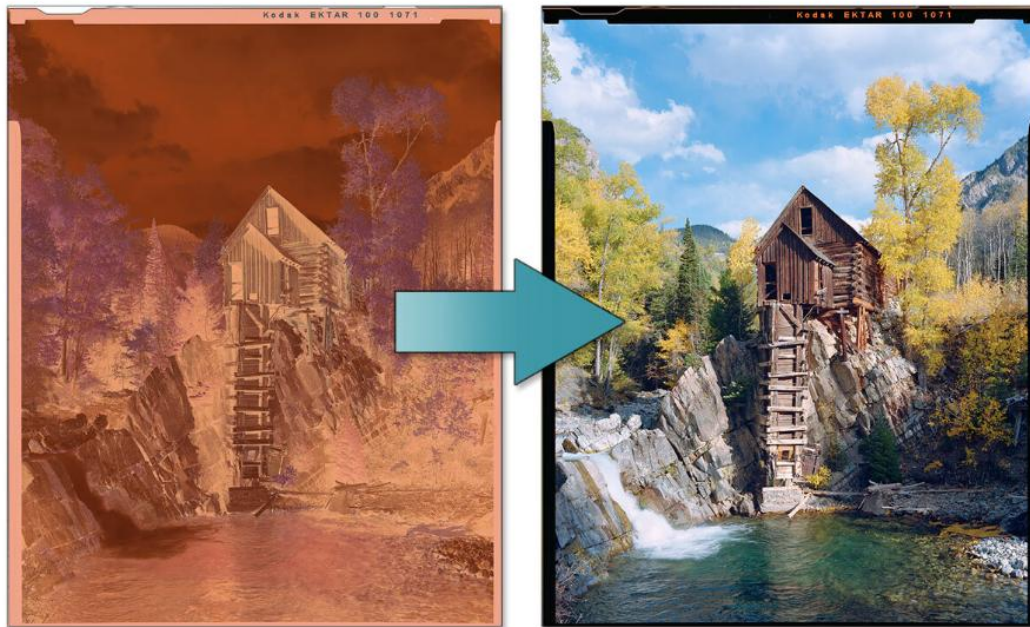
What Equipment is Needed?

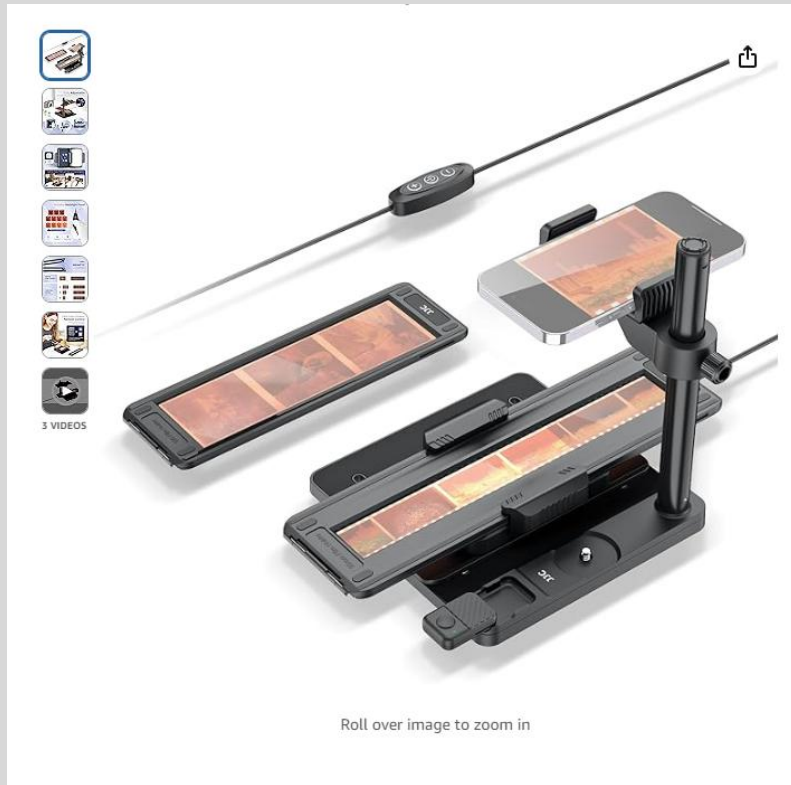
